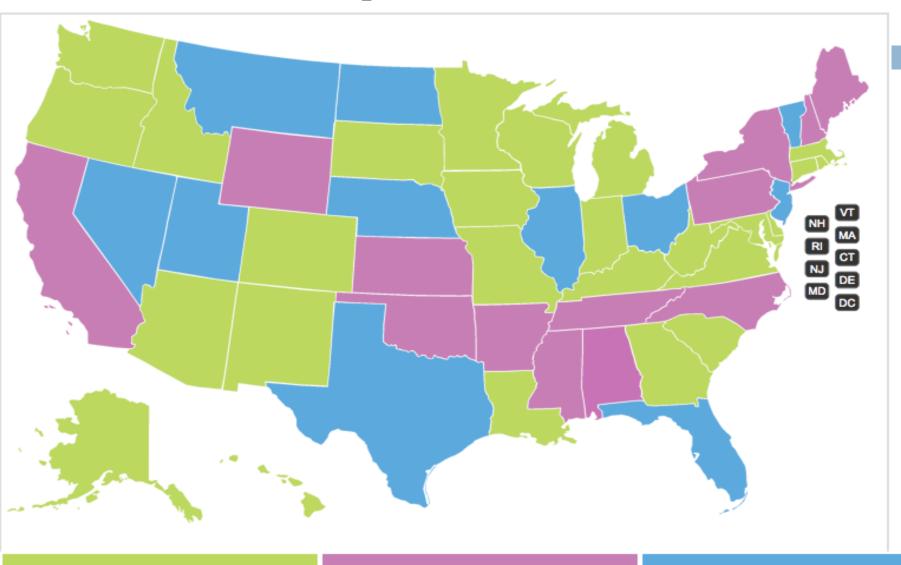

- ✓ Allows students to more readily understand and access goal setting and assignments.
- ✓ Allows staff or teachers or parents to monitor student, group or class-wide completion

- ✓ A useful data collection tool for ASCA RAMP

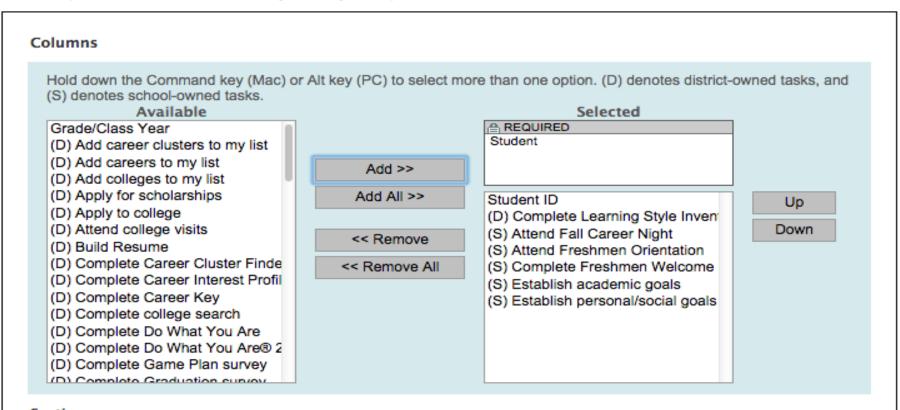
